CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN Online Engagement (February-March 2018)

SUMMARY

Overview

In February 2018, County residents were asked to provide feedback over a 30-day period regarding the types of investments they believed were important considerations as the County Manager was developing his proposed FY 2019-2028 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). Respondents were asked to give feedback on the importance that they personally placed on funding 17 key capital areas using a sliding scale from "Not Important" to "Very Important." Three additional qualitative questions were included using open-ended response options. A full list of questions can be found in Appendix 1.

Outreach and Communications

A variety of communication strategies were used to share this engagement opportunity with residents, businesses and other interested stakeholders. Information was included in the County's weekly e-newsletter *Inside Arlington* and other departmental e-newsletters. The feedback form was also highlighted on social media, including the County's *Facebook, Twitter and Next Door* accounts. Targeted outreach was conducted with stakeholders who participated in the 2018 Budget and JFAC roundtables. Stakeholders who had previously expressed interest in capital-related issues (fields, transportation, parks, etc.) received direct emails inviting them to provide feedback using the online feedback form. In addition, County staff conducted in-person outreach at farmer's markets, libraries, and residential buildings supported by the Arlington Partnership for Affordable Housing.

Responses

The online engagement yielded responses from 3,038 unique individuals from neighborhoods located across the county (Appendix 2). Participants also submitted over 4,000 comments in response to the three open-ended questions. The feedback was analyzed and provided to an Investment Review Board working with the County Manager's Office on the development of the proposed CIP. It was then presented to the County Manager and his leadership team to help inform their deliberations on Arlington's capital needs.

Key Themes


Several themes emerged across both the quantitative and qualitative responses. This includes feedback received on 17 questions regarding 'types of investments' that were important, as well as 4,000+ comments submitted across the three qualitative questions.

- Invest in schools to address school growth
- Support the maintenance of existing assets (e.g., roads/paving, parks, community centers, water/sewer, and libraries)
- Support Metro;

- Invest in pedestrian safety (including sidewalks, crosswalks, crossing signals and streetlights); and
- Adhere to being fiscally responsible.

The average response for each of the 17 different investment areas asked about in the quantitative questions is shown in the graph below.

Participants were also asked "What do you value most about living, working and/or playing in Arlington County?" The word cloud in Appendix 3 shows the responses to this question, illuminating words that show up more often than others.




