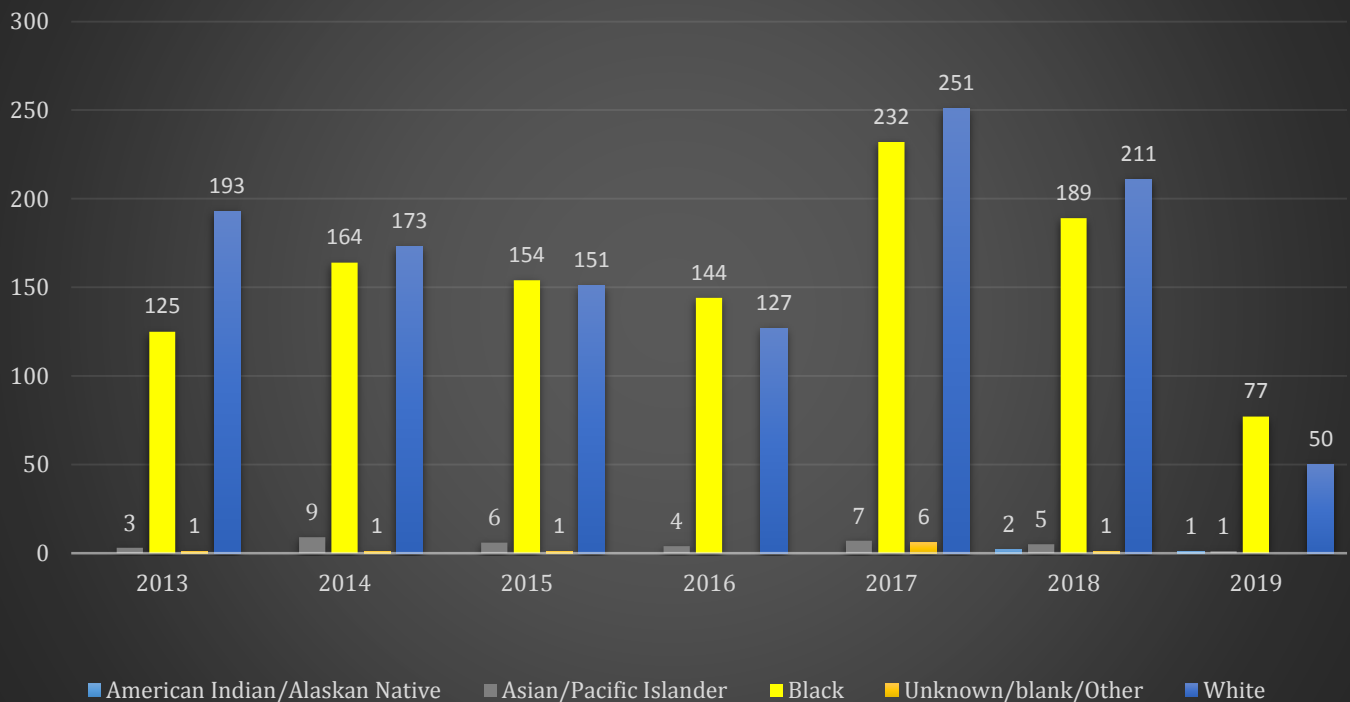
NOTE: Felony v. misdemeanors at schools examine *offenses* that occurred at school, but where the arrest may have occurred elsewhere.

White juvenile arrestees make up slightly more than half of the total juvenile arrestees from 2013-present.

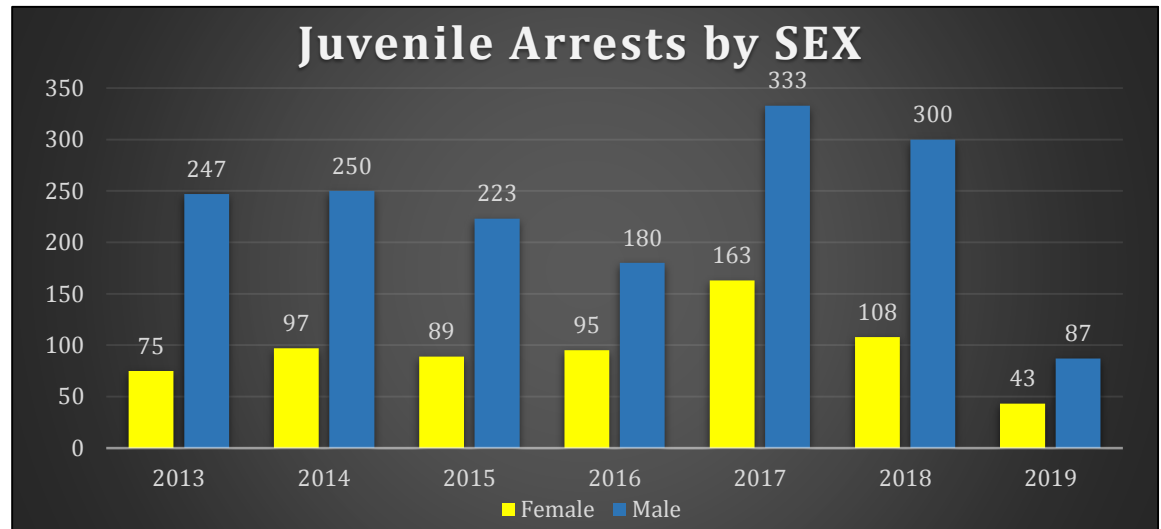
