ARLINGTON COUNTY DETENTION FACILITY INMATE WORK RELEASE PROGRAM & CRITERIA

The Sheriff's Office provides employment opportunities and training for inmates that helps to promote self-sufficiency and aids in their rehabilitation. Inmates assigned to full-time workforce positions are compensated by payment, other privileges (approved by the Director), or under certain sentence guidelines, credited days off their sentence. Inmates have an opportunity to gain meaningful experience and marketable vocational skills to strengthen work ethic and self-esteem which are necessary in returning to the community. Training and supervision for such positions may be provided by the food and commissary contractors, Arlington County Libraries, Arlington County Schools, Good News Jail and Prison Ministry, and other Sheriff's Office staff.

The Sheriff's Office Work Release program provides intensive community-based supervision on the job site for qualifying in-custody inmates. Supervision of this program is greater than probation but less than traditional incarceration and represents a critical component of the incremental release process. Inmates interested in this program must go through an application process and meet strict criteria.

Inmate Work Release Program Criteria:

- Facility Custody level 4 sentenced to 3 years or less with Goodtime Release date within twelve months
- No prior escape charges
- No prior stalking or felony sex offenses. No felony violent/assaultive charges. Assaultive charges will be reviewed for appropriateness of placements.
- No detainers or pending litigation
- Positive past and current jail adjustments
- Clear and current employment availability or able to meet standards for Work Release Status
- Understand and agree with appropriate offender contracts
