### Saturday, March 28th

#### 12:30 An Introduction to Metacognitive

The demo by **Anya Getter** will introduce you to this exciting medium, show basic techniques for applying alcohol inks, and different surfaces that can be used with alcohol inks. Ages: 16 and up. #### 2:00 to 4:00 Demonstration of Cold Wax Painting

Some cold wax medium paintings are created using a variety of implements, additional mediums and forms of oil paint. Watch as **Jackie Afram** demonstrates the use of oil paint, oil sticks or bars, or pan pastels of different surfaces which lead to interesting outcomes. Learn why the materials and implements are used to achieve interesting paintings. Ages: 16 and up.

#### 3:00 Demonstration of Sumi-e: Painting on Rice Paper

**Carol Waite** will demonstrate Sumi-e (Oriental Brush Painting) which derives from the original brush writing. Special ink (Sumi) is used along with brushes made from rabbit, horse, or other animals hair. Brushes are loaded with several shades of ink, or a combination of colors so one stroke creates shading. Ages: Adult.
