



SCOOTER SAFELY

KNOW THE LAW Reference Virginia State Code Chapter 46.2

- Signal your intention to stop or turn
- Do not park the scooter where it impedes the normal movement of pedestrian or other traffic, or where parking is prohibited
- Yield to pedestrians in crosswalks
- Give an audible signal before passing or overtaking any pedestrian
- Ride no more than two abreast on a highway and move into single file formation when being overtaken from the rear by a faster vehicle
- The use of scooters is prohibited on interstate highways
- Scooters must have a headlight on the front and a red reflector on the rear when operating between sunset and sunrise
- Scooters should use bike lanes, when available

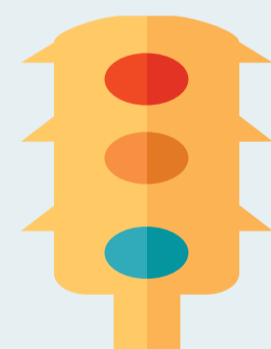
PRACTICE SAFE RIDING BEHAVIORS
