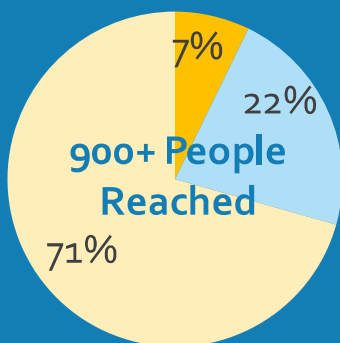
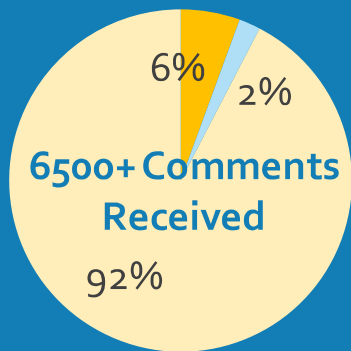

### Vision Zero Overview

In 2019, the Arlington County Board committed to enhancing safety on the County's transportation system by adopting Vision Zero.

Vision Zero is a comprehensive and holistic strategy to eliminate transportation-related fatalities and serious injuries. We are currently working with you—members of the community—to create an Action Plan to achieve these Vision Zero safety goals.

### Vision Zero Goals

Arlington County shared the draft goals for the Vision Zero Action Plan and asked for community feedback. Overall, there was agreement about the importance of these goals.

When asked to rate how well the goals addressed community priorities related to the future of safe transportation, all goals received an average rating of 3.5 or above on a scale of 1 to 5.

The revised goals, incorporating community input, can be found below.

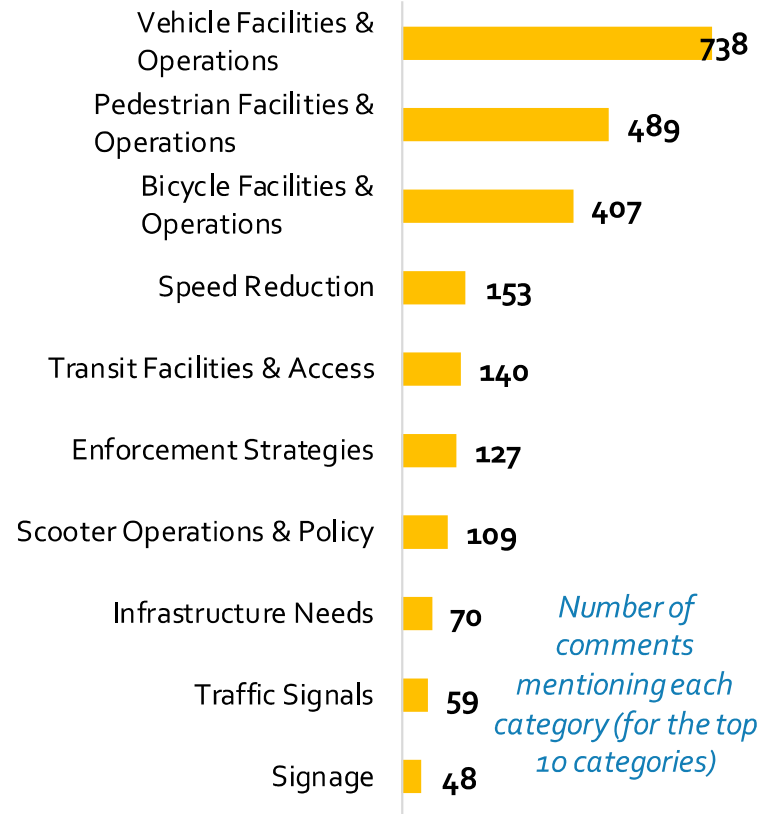

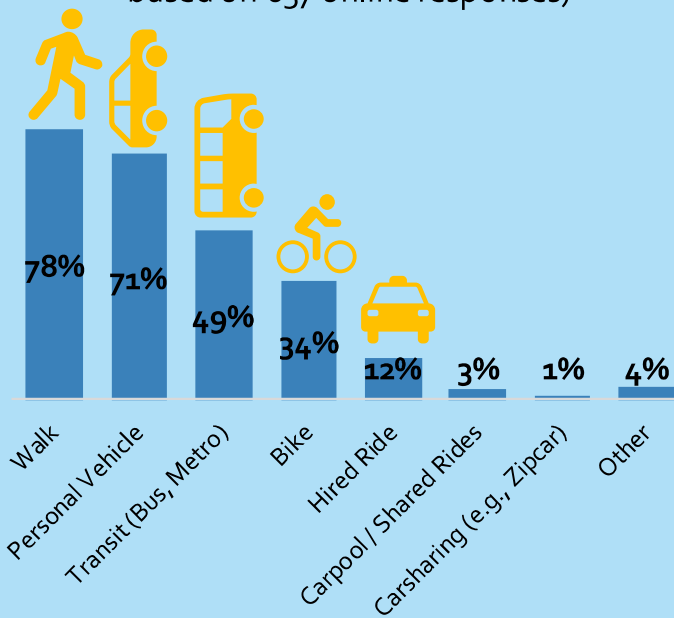
**Arlington's Safety Priorities**

Arlington County asked the community about priorities related to safe transportation and visions for the future. Responses supported the importance of safe facilities and operations for all modes. Reducing speeds, improving access to Metro and buses, and ensuring holistic enforcement on the transportation system were also viewed as key safety priorities for the Vision Zero Action Plan.
