FAPT NORMS

WELCOME

- Listen first, speak second (i.e., everyone may take a turn to speak)
- Limit use of acronyms (i.e., instead of "CSA" say "Children's Service's Act")
- Request an interpreter if English is not your primary language
- Speak slowly and in short sentences for interpretation, if needed
- Refrain from cell phone or computer use to provide undivided attention
- Use everyone's proper names, unless requested otherwise
- Please feel free to step outside or take a quick break, if needed

TREATMENT TEAM

- Be clear and concise in your progress updates and treatment review
- Highlight the youth and family's strengths and contributions
- Ensure the family has space to share their own view and progress update
- Be mindful of time allotted
- Accept feedback, questions, and comments of the FAPT members to make sure services for the child and family are appropriate

FAMILY

- Be sure to ask questions, share concerns, and voice your opinions
- Please bring anyone to FAPT who you feel is supportive in your child's care
- It is your right to agree or disagree with the services requested or action plan
- It's important to tell us if you agree or disagree with a service or plan

CLOSING

- Ask questions to seek understanding and make sure you know what decisions have been made
- Provide feedback about your experience through the FAPT Feedback Survey
