## FAMILY ASSESSMENT AND PLANNING TEAM

Do you have a child involved in the child welfare or court services program and need support to be successful?

Does your child have trouble managing difficult behaviors or emotions?

Does your child receive Special Education services and struggle with challenges at school, in your home or community?

### If "Yes," then FAPT may be for you and your family!

FAPT is a multi-partner team that help children and families succeed at home, in school, and in the community.

- We value your privacy, focus on your strengths, and work together to get your child what they need
- We have flexible weekly daytime and evening meetings to accommodate your family's schedule
- You may bring people who will help you work towards your family's goals
- FAPT members include individuals in Child Welfare, Schools, Courts, Behavioral Health, a parent with lived experience, and a someone from a private agency
