

## VISIONING FEEDBACK

### QUESTION #1:

What do you consider to be the biggest potential for this site?

Comment 1: Open Space and Protect the Environment and Natural Resources

Comment 2: Leave As Is – Green Space

Comment 3: Open Green Space for Casual Use – Arlington is rapidly losing these kinds of spaces that are essential for physical & mental health. Leave the site w/ only natural infrastructure – NO BUILT facilities.

Comment 4: County should acquire more land nearby when it becomes available.

### QUESTION #2:

What would you consider a “missed opportunity” if it wasn’t sited on this site?

Comment 1: Lease Missionhurst lower parking lot for Salt Dome parking.

Comment 2: MAXIMIZE GREEN SPACE

Comment 3: A childrens park would be a nice addition & leave the green space.

Comment 4: Opportunity – restore the health of Donaldson Run headwaters, slope protection, restoration of native tree canopy, eradicate native (invasive) species

Comment 5: Opportunity – use of cistern/greywater system to dilutemulch site runoff and redistribute to the surrounding forest and golf course. If that is feasible, replicate at othe high-points in County.

Comment 6: We need more Open Space – do not put more built structures here, PLEASE.

Comment 7: 1.) Preserve mature tree canopy, 2.) Respect the Resource Protection Area (RPA), 3.) Respect the existing topography and 4.) Protect Trail Head.

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## QUESTION #3:

What would you identify as some of the key “pain points” the surrounding neighborhood may have with the existing operations on the site?

Comment 1: “Pain Points” are many. Old Dominion – Glebe Road neighborhood surrounds a busy Old Dominion & Glebe Road. We need the green areas for peace of mind & health.

Comment 2: Consider enhancing the area in question with quiet green grounds like a lot of parks in Europe.

Comment 3: Absence of a Park in Old Dominion neighborhood.

Comment 4: Inadequate buffer between dome and Old Dominion Road & homes on surrounding roads

Comment 5: Does shift change have to be on site? Maybe someplace else nearby?

- Not enough trees and cover of site
- Lack of parks in area
- Wildlife / deer / foxes in area

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### QUESTION #4:

The Task Force charge represents an opportunity to mitigate some of the impacts of required County operations on the site (think appropriate visual, light, or noise screening and buffer treatments). What are some of your ideas for mitigating the County's operational uses?

Comment 1: There really should be a better buffer between Dome and Old Dominion. I have always thought that the current buffer was below Arlington standards (more space, trees).

Comment 2: Maintain the trees that are there and those to be planted.

Comment 3: I am not convinced that there is a need for more/larger facilities to meet the needs in North Arlington. I have heard no such needs in open forums. Folks complain but is there a compelling need?

Comment 4: Plant more trees and natural vegetation around the facilities area to create sound-sight buffer.

Comment 5: Can some facilities be built in "dug out" areas that would minimize sound and sight issues?

Comment 6:

- Impairs flow of traffic on Old Dominion.
- More green space, tree cover, buffers.
- Parks are limited in the area and badly needed.
