## **ZOA-11-04 Adopted December 10, 2011**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REENACT AND RECODIFY THE ARLINGTON COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE, SECTIONS 20 (APPENDIX A) AND 34 IN ORDER TO PERMIT TEMPORARY SIDEWALK SIGNS, COMMERCIAL MESSAGES ON UMBRELLAS AND COORDINATED SIGNS FOR PUBLIC PARKING GARAGES; IN ORDER TO REDUCE OR PREVENT CONGESTION IN THE STREETS, TO ENCOURAGE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AND FOR OTHER REASONS REQUIRED BY THE PUBLIC NECESSITY, CONVENIENCE AND GENERAL WELFARE, AND GOOD ZONING PRACTICE.

Be it ordained that the Arlington County Zoning Ordinance provisions in Sections 20 (Appendix A) and 34 are hereby amended, reenacted and recodified as follows in order to permit temporary sidewalk signs, commercial messages on umbrellas and coordinated signs for public parking garages; in order to reduce or prevent congestion in the streets, to encourage economic development; and for other reasons required by the public necessity, convenience and general welfare, and good zoning practice:

117	Signs. Compliance with these standards shall be determined by the

119	limited to: location; color; size; shape and lettering. The sign shall not
120	exceed six and one-half (6.5) square feet in size nor shall any dimension of
121	the sign exceed four (4) feet.
121	b. When a sign for a public parking facility is approved and placed pursuant
123	to this Section 34.K, 34.F.7 no other parking garage identification signs
123	may be on the exterior of the building.
125	c. Amendments to approved comprehensive sign plans shall not be required
126	for signs permitted by this Section 34.K-34.F.7., but such signs shall be
127	permitted in addition to the signs allowed under a comprehensive sign
128	plan.
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132	K. Signs Permitted in Specified Areas with Permits.
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134	Public parking facilities in the Rosslyn Metro Station area, bounded by North Rhodes Street, Lee
135	Highway, Arlington Boulevard and Arlington Ridge Road may obtain a sign permit from the
136	Zoning Administrator for the signs described below and subject to the following regulations:
137	1. One (1) building sign or projecting sign per garage entrance to a public parking
138	facility which identifies the location of publicly accessible parking. For purposes
139	of this Section 34.K, a public parking facility is defined as a garage that provides
140	parking for members of the general public, at a minimum, after business from 6
141	p.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Friday and either all weekend or for at least eight

142		(8) hours, in total, between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. The sign
143		shall meet all standards prescribed by the Zoning Administrator including, but no
144		limited to: location; color; size; shape and lettering. The sign shall not exceed size
145		and one-half (6.5 square feet in size nor shall any dimension of the sign exceed
