Who We Are

The Mission of the Alexandria/Arlington Regional Workforce Council is to advance workforce development programs and initiatives that achieve sustainable economic growth in the City of Alexandria and Arlington County, Virginia.

The Council provides funding to the region's two American Job Centers, Alexandria Workforce Development Center and Arlington Employment Center, as well as many employment services and training programs for employers, jobseekers, and youth.

The Council is responsible for administering more than \$1 million of Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act services in the region annually. These services include financial support for college tuition and vocational certifications, internships and supportive services, such as subsidies for transportation, childcare, books and fees while in school, or uniforms for employment.

The Alexandria/Arlington Regional Workforce Council is an Equal Opportunity Program.

Who We Serve

Job-Seekers

Our network of American Job Centers and community partners assists job-seekers, including Adults, Youth, Veterans, Older Workers, and People with Disabilities, in developing the skills and experience necessary to meet the needs of regional employers. Services include:

- Basic skills assessment
- Paid work experience and training
- Career counseling
- Job search and labor market information
- Resource rooms, fax machines, and computer labs
- Subsidized job training (based on eligibility)

Employers

The Regional Workforce Council assists employers with the recruitment and retention of employees by:

- Offering subsidized training for current and/or future staff
- Providing hiring assistance
- Creating initiatives in response to local business needs

What is WIOA

The Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act (WIOA) is a reemployment and training program designed to assist dislocated workers, other adults and youth to enter into high-demand occupations and gain livable wages within their geographical areas.

You may be eligible if...

- You have been permanently laid off from your employment.
- You are unemployed or underemployed with additional barriers to employment. Income guidelines may apply.
- You are 14-24 years old and have barriers to education and employment. Income guidelines apply.
