Affordable Housing: Mr. Cristeal presented the Affordable Housing Study draft that was presented to the Arlington County Board, Commissioners asked for clarification about some issues raised like: ways of implementation, percentage of condominiums that are rentals, parking and parking space in affordable units, schools geographic distribution, market rentals and market affordable, use of AHIF on assistance. Mr. Cristeal asked for a letter of recommendation or support to be send to the County Board, and also feedback. A motion to send a letter of support was approved.

Besides affordable housing what they do is forecast of the county future, student enrolment, will people live, parks, and fire stations. The recommendations will be given to the county board.
