**1. Welcome and Introductions**

- The meeting was called to order by Ginger Brown (GB), JFAC Chair at 7:05 PM; quorum present.

**2. Chair's Report**

- The Joint Work Session will be held on June 27 in the Arlington County Board Room at Courthouse Plaza from 6 pm – 9 pm.
- Commission meetings and Subcommittee meetings will be in recess until September.
- A letter will be written to address concerns about Affordable Housing.

**3. Approval of May Meeting Minutes**

- With the addition of Janine Valasco to those present, the May JFAC Commission minutes were unanimously approved.

#### 4. What Fits Activity Part 4 – Buck and Carlin Springs Scenarios (Updated)

- GB and Kris Krider (KK) presented on the What Fits Activity Part 4-Buck and Carlin Springs scenarios.
- The scenarios were reviewed briefly in order with the goal to condense the number of options to present to the County Board.
- ART and school bus parking was not favored and should be a last resort for Buck or Carlin Springs scenarios. The commission discussed the concept of bus parking as temporary allowing for future flexibility. The commission also discussed the idea of bus parking elsewhere within (or outside) the County.
- Carlin Spring Scenarios: the commission determined Scenario C was preferable for flexibility; Scenario B was dropped as it was similar to C. Scenarios A, C, & E (long term option) were kept.
- Buck Scenarios: the commission determined that Scenario C is the most preferred option. Scenario A will be dropped and Scenario C and E (long term option) will be kept.
- The commission clarified that the scenarios were not ranked rather presented in the order they had been developed over the course of the exercises.

#### 5. Phase 2 Draft Report Recommendations for Phase 3

- Greg Greely (GG) provided highlights of the Phase 2 Draft Report. The commission focused on the content of the recommendations.
- GB also stated that she is developing a work plan for the commission.
- The commission recommended the report be revised to have an executive summary with recommendations at the beginning of the report.
- General discussion around clarifying recommendations pertaining to the 16<sup>th</sup> Street N properties and the Arcland swap.
- Ensure discussion about the appropriateness of uses within the surrounding communities as it had been omitted from the draft report.

#### 6. Announcements and Public Comment

- There were 12 speakers for public comment. Public comment included many remarks that included thanking commissioners for their work. The general theme of the public comment was asking JFAC to express, in its report, the discontent of the community to have ART and school bus parking at any of the sites even on a temporary basis.
