- Dedicated APS and County staff
- Focused on long-term site optimization; setting foundation for the BPLC and PFRC
 - Jan-Apr meetings focused on learning about the process and visioning
 - Apr-Jul meetings will focus on phasing
 - Final recommendation submitted in August
