

## Docket Comments from Cherie Takemoto – 11/14/2019

Here are my specific comments

I think that they need to incorporate family members/significant others, as appropriate. In many cases, the family is the foundation for helping to get the person into treatment and reinforcing the terms of the plan. If there are such family/significant others available, they should certainly be considered. Below are my specific suggested edits:

P9. Informed Choice. There should be family involvement, as appropriate, at this phase.

P9. Treatment supports should also include family, significant others and community supports, as appropriate. If family members or other significant others are to be a part of the treatment plan (as will be the case in many instances) they need to be a part of the plan and agree to it.

P. 13 – Flow chart should say “SMI/DD/DD” instead of “SMI/DD”. It should also include family/sig others as appropriate.

P. 14 – report should also indicate the level of support from family/sig others and recommend ways they can be involved in the process.

P. 15 – family/sig other should be involved in the development of the plan, as appropriate.

P. 30 – #6d - agree to participate in **behavioral health**, mental health, **and/or substance use disorder treatment**

P. 36 - 11) **Substance use disorder** treatment

p. 49 – should include contact information for family member or significant other (if appropriate) as well as permission (release of information) to contact and share information with family member. You might also wish to add a check box (all that apply) for MI – DD – or DD
