Re: Update to the *Maywood Design Guidelines*

Dear Maywood Owner or Resident:

As you may be aware, the Arlington County Historical Affairs and Landmark Review Board (HALRB), Arlington County Historic Preservation Program (HPP) staff, Maywood Community Association, and residents of the neighborhood began a collaborative process in November 2017 to update the *Maywood Design Guidelines* with the intent to streamline the approval process by which owners can make improvements and modifications to their homes. This group, called the Maywood Design Guidelines Committee (MCG), has been meeting periodically and has a draft of the proposed updates to the *Maywood Design Guidelines*. At its January 22, 2020, public hearing, the HALRB voted unanimously to support the proposed updates to the *Maywood Design Guidelines*. The HALRB also made a motion to send the amendments forward for the County Board's consideration. The County Board first will consider a Request to Advertise the proposed updates at its February 22nd meeting. The County Board's public hearing to consider adoption of the proposed changes to the *Maywood Design Guidelines* will be scheduled for either its March 21st or March 24th meeting.
