CARES ACT UPDATE

Arlington County allocated \$1.03 million in CARES Act Funding for Eviction Prevention and rental assistance.

- \$790,932 in CDBG rental assistance
- \$121,150 in CSBG rental assistance

- \$103,000 for staff support
- \$15,000 for outreach and outreach materials

Funding began on June 19th and Thrive began assisting cases for June Rents

- Income requirements vary slightly for CDBG and CSBG
 - No more than 3 months of rental assistance (June 2020 going forward)
 - \$1,500 cap per month including rental and utility assistance

CARES ACT IN ACTION - JUNE 19TH-JULY 31ST

- 231 Households Assisted
- 416 disbursements (1.8 per household)
 - 384 CDBG checks
 - 32 CSBG checks
- Average disbursement \$1,305
- Remaining Funds

CONCLUSIONS

- CDBG and CBSG have been successful in preventing evictions due to missed payments for June, July and August rents.
 - Funding will be depleted by the beginning of September. Arlington Thrive and DHS will work with DHS and County Leadership to advocate and identify additional sources of eviction prevention funding.
